

Sanjiang: City Guide

Guangxi Province : Sanjiang

The best kept hometown of Dong nationality of Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, with the complete traditional folk culture, as well as myth colors; a hot spot with national customs and sightseeing.

Location: situated between north latitude 25°4' - 26°0' and east longitude 108°14' - 109°45', in the north area of the Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region; at the middle reaches of the Xunjiang River; in the joint area of the three provinces: Hunan, Guizhou province and Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region

Neighboring Areas: Yunnan, Guizhou, Hunan and Guangdong provinces

Physical Features: surrounded by mountains with average elevation of 80-100m

Nationalities: Dong, Han, Zhuang, Miao, Yao, Manchu, Hui, Maonan, Gelao and Yi

Climatic Features: subtropical humid monsoon climate; with enough sunshine of more than 1600 hours annually; mild; with long frost-free period of more than 300 days

Average Temperature: annual average temperature of 17-19°C
Rainfall: plenty of rain, concentrated in summers; annual precipitation of 1493 mm

Rivers: the Rongjiang River, Xunjiang River

Local Highlights: the building of the Dong nationality, March the third Festival, Fireworks and Firecrackers Festival
