

Sanya : City Guide

Hainan Province : Sanya

An important political, economic, cultural and foreign trade port in the southern part of Hainan Province, also a famous coastal tourist city with tropical landscapes and special local customs.

Location: on the southern tip of Hainan Island; on a peninsula parallel to the coast and linked to the mainland by bridges

Neighboring Areas: Guangdong province

Urban Population: 440,000

Area: 1,919 sq km

Nationalities: Han, Hui, Miao, and Li

Climatic Features: located in low-latitude area with tropical coastal monsoon climate; known as "a big natural hot house"; 2,563 sunshine hours all the year-round

Average Temperature: 25.4C annually with the highest of 35.8C and the lowest of 5.1C

Rainfall: annual rainfall is 1,279mm

Mountains: Mt. Wuzhi, Mt. Yingge, Mt. Ezong, Mt. Mihou, Mt. Yajiada and Mt. Diaolu

Rivers: Nandu River, Changhua River, Wanquan River

Products: rice, sweet potatoes, peanuts, sugarcane, rubber, coconut, areca, banana, mango, pineapple, winter melons
